

All About Wa-Thik-Ane

Where is Camp Wa-Thik-Ane?

Located in Morin Heights, Quebec, approximately 85km north of Montreal, Camp Wa-Thik-Ane (WAH-tic-ANNIE) is situated on 300 acres of pristine wilderness on the shores of Lac Bouchette.

What health and safety standards are followed?

All programs are planned and staffed according to Girl Guides of Canada *Safe Guide* standards. Health and safety is managed by qualified First Aiders and lifeguards.

Who will take care of my daughter?

Fully screened and trained adult volunteers will be responsible for all girls. Supervision ratios will be based on Girl Guides of Canada - *Safe Guide* standards. The Guiders will run the program primarily in English with translation to French as needed.

Where will my daughter sleep?

All campers will sleep in large canvas tents on permanent wooden platforms. *Wee Camp Together* campers will be placed with their accompanying female adult and another camp pair. All other campers will share tents with 2 or 3 other girls their own age.

Can my daughter bunk with her friends?

Girls can indicate on the application form if they are coming to camp with a particular friend, however larger groups may be asked to pair up.

What will my daughter eat?

Meals are based on requirements in Canada's food guide and are designed to be balanced and nutritious. Traditional camp food such as hamburgers and grilled cheese will be served, along with favourites such as spaghetti and chicken. Fruit and vegetables will be served at every meal and campers will also have access to a variety of snacks outside regular meals.



What if a camper has special needs, disabilities or dietary restrictions?

Site Guiders will do their best to accommodate special needs. However, to help us provide the best possible experience for campers please note any special requirements on the application form in the "Other" section. This helps us to identify special needs or menus a camper might require.

Do I send a deposit with the application?

Yes. A 50% non-refundable deposit must accompany the application form. Payment can be made by credit card (Mastercard or Visa), certified cheque or money order. (*payable to Girl Guides of Canada-Quebec Council*) Balance of payment is due by June 1, 2010. Camp reservations not paid in full by June 1 will automatically be cancelled and your deposit will not be refunded. Payment in full can be made immediately.

What is your refund policy?

Requests for refunds of camp fees must be submitted in writing by July 5, 2010. Refunds will not be considered after that date. Any request due to medical circumstances that are supported with appropriate documentation will be reviewed on a case by case basis. All deposits are non-refundable. Your deposit is your reservation for your space and when made GGC-Quebec Council commits financial resources for supplies to provide a quality program. No refunds will be given for campers arriving late, leaving early, or attending only a portion of the program.

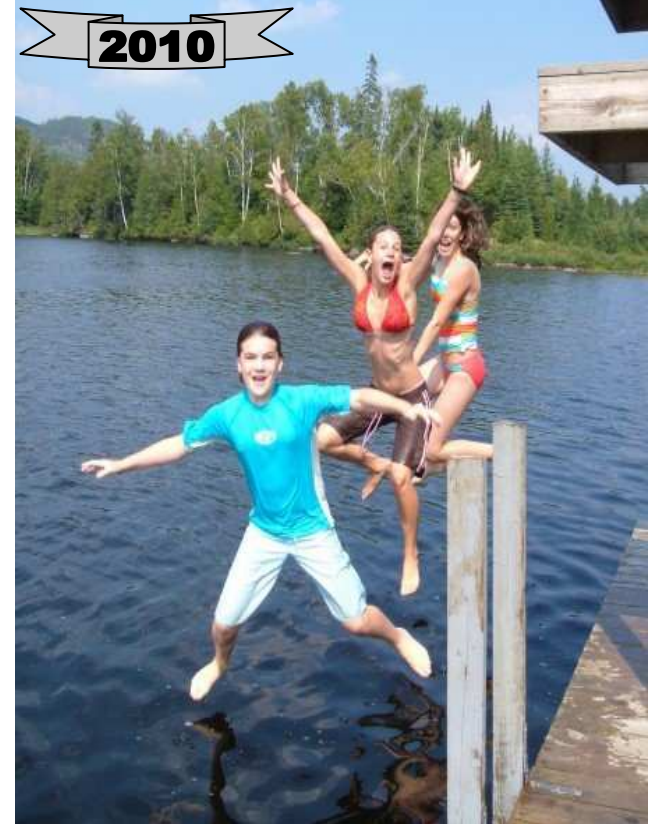

5 - 8 years old with a female adult
Saturday July 31—Monday August 2

- Explore Wa-Thik-Ane
- Get wet at the waterfront
- Get a taste of outdoor cooking
- Get creative with some camp crafts
- Learn about camp duties
- Sing a song at campfire

A 2 night summer **tent** camp experience for 5-8 year olds with Mom or another female adult. Each “mom” and girl will share a tent with another “mom” and girl team. Most camp activities and duties will be done together, however, there will be some opportunities for both to gain independence and comfort apart at camp. All participants are expected to help with camp chores and fully participate in all activities. This is an introduction to camp life and will focus on activities found in the Spark and Brownie programs.

Camp fee: \$ 125 (for 2 - tax included)

Camp fee includes:

- 2 nights accommodation in a canvas tent for both participants together
- 2 breakfasts, 3 lunches, 2 dinners and snacks
- All program activities
- Opportunities to get to know your daughter and for both of you to learn about living outdoors

Camp fees do NOT include:

- Transportation
- Personal equipment including sleeping bag, mattress and rain gear
- Tuck shop purchases (treats, badges etc...)

All participants are expected to help with camp chores and fully participate in all activities. This is an introduction to being independent at camp and is based on the Brownie & 1st year Guide programs.

Camp fee: \$ 200 (per girl tax included)

- 4 nights accommodation in a canvas tent
- All meals and snacks
- All program activities
- Opportunities for your daughter to gain independence and learn about living outdoors

All participants are expected to help with camp chores and fully participate in all activities. This camp, for new and experienced campers, will focus on activities found in the Guide and Pathfinder programs.

Camp fee: \$ 275 (per person tax included)

- 6 nights accommodation in a canvas tent
- All meals and snacks
- All program activities
- Opportunities for your daughter to gain independence and leadership in the outdoors
